OBJECTIVES

The course aims to provide the students with increased speaking abilities and/or, more simply, with a reliable, structured model for preparing and delivering effective presentations. They will learn different communication techniques that serve as a basis for effective speaking.

The first part of the course is based on the acquisition of the essential conceptual knowledge, the underpinnings of Public Speaking, which, in the second part, will be reinforced by a more practical session aimed to encourage, guide and support the students in their development of a valuable, appealing, effective dissertation.

Students will be introduced to a variety of techniques which will raise and enhance their own potential, their self-appraisal and awareness. They will train to become analytical listeners, thus developing the ability to analyze and evaluate presentations made by others and, indeed, their own.

They will learn to develop, demonstrate and deliver a wide range of skills related to verbal and nonverbal communication, research competencies through researching, preparing, and delivering relevant presentations to specific and non specific audiences. They will learn how to ask good questions and provide meaningful answers to questions.

The ultimate aim is for the students to acquire a solid understanding of the basic skills needed for effective communication and gain more confidence to speak publicly in a variety of situations.

CONTENUTI

- The benefits of public speaking, communication processes, ethical speaking and categories of speeches.
- Clarity of thought and speech, greater physical and vocal presence, better breath support, tools to strengthen the voice, ways to increase the range and carrying power of the voice, guidelines on how to keep the voice healthy and a greater sense of confidence when public speaking.
- Analyzing an Audience: Adapting to audiences, evaluation techniques and listener needs.
- Listening and Feedback: Improving listening and note-taking skills The four stages of listening and the different types of listening
- Selecting the Topic: Purpose and Thesis of Your Speech General and specific purpose speeches - Developing a thesis and timed speeches.
- Researching the Speech: Research strategies and types, source reliability and supporting material.
- Organizing the Speech: Organizational patterns for informative and persuasive speeches, main ideas and supporting ideas
- o Outlining the Speech: Introduction, body and conclusion of a speech.
- Language and Style: Inclusive and vivid language, imagery, diction (both in English and Italian) and speaking styles.
- Reasoning and Rhetorical Proof: Significance of ethos, logos and pathos Persuasive speech and types of reasoning.
- Speech Delivery: Four categories of speech delivery, nonverbal communication, pronunciation and speech rehearsal.
- Types of Speeches: Informative, persuasive and special occasion speeches.

- Selecting and Incorporating Visual Supports: Advantages and disadvantages of PowerPoint Copyright and fair use issues Preparing visual aids.
- Speech Evaluation: Why evaluating speeches is important Assessing ourselves as speakers and assessing the speaking abilities of others.
- Preparing for an Impromptu Speech: Developing, preparing and making an impromptu speech on short notice.
